- 11. Authorize District staff to open bank account for loan proceeds;
- 12. Review and approve Sales and Use Tax Report;
- 13. Review and approve Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorize writing-off delinquent tax accounts;
- 14. Status of closing of loan for emergency services vehicles, equipment and radios;

If the Board decides to enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the time to be discussed and provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.

The Board of Commissioners, NFR Board of Directors and/or District staff may inquire about a subject not specifically listed on this agenda pursuant to §551.042, Texas Government Code. Responses are limited to a recitation of existing policy or a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation or decision shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda of a future meeting.
