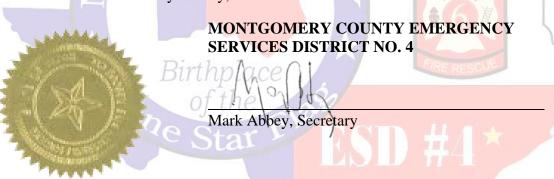

 - b. review additional construction expenditures for Station No. 63 and take any necessary actions on same;
- 10. Review and approve Treasurer's monthly report, including disposition of District's bank accounts;
- 11. Review and approve monthly invoices, including authorize Southside Bank loan payment for Station No. 61 construction (due May 25, 2023);
- 12. Adopt Order Regarding Annual Review of Rules, Policies, and Code of Ethics for the Investment of District Funds;
- 13. Review and approve Sales and Use Tax Report;
- 14. Review and approve Tax Assessor-Collector's Report;
- 15. Review and approve District Emergency Response Plan, as necessary;

- 21. Review District real estate matters;
- 22. Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code ("Open Meetings Act") to discuss District matters, as may be necessary;

- 23. Miscellaneous inquiry pursuant to Section 551.042 of the Open Meetings Act to hold limited discussions; and

These purposes include: receive legal advice from its attorney(s) pursuant to §551.071, Texas Government Code; discussing real property matters pursuant to §551.072, Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073, Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to §551.074 of the Open Meetings Act; and, discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076, Texas Government Code. If the Board decides to enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the time to be discussed and provision of the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.

The Board of Commissioners, NFR Board of Directors and/or District staff may inquire about a subject not specifically listed on this agenda pursuant to §551.042, Texas Government Code. Responses are limited to a recitation of existing policy or a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation or decision shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda of a future meeting.
